5.1. [PAC Presentation](#)

- *Question: A parent member asked about our CTE program.*
- *Response: it was answered that we are planning to expand the program for more CTE over the next few years and that the principal is passionate about making the program larger.*

5.3. [iReady Pre-Assessment Data Presentation](#)

A presentation on iReady pre-assessment data will be led by Operations and Accountability Facilitator, Bethany Burgos.

- *Question: parent member asked if teachers actually look at questions that the students are missing to help guide with instruction? Is the missed content reviewed?*
- *Response: staff member replied that iReady does not show exact questions missed, it shows where the student needs help and support. Teachers meet with parents to show where the student needs help. Teachers have support in how to read data and how to identify the student's needs. It was done at our PLC and submit to know how to help parents for PLA. If it*

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was for VLA, we help the teachers to identify the needs so that they can guide the class instruction. Also, EasyCBM is another layer that can more specifically be needed if the student is needing to take that.

- *Question: parent member asked how committees selecting curriculum, was there any feedback about what worked and if there is any data to support what worked.*
- *Response: staff member answered that so much time is put into evaluating the curriculum list and ensuring that the curriculum added is standards based so that the child can succeed. In our Parces data, we are able to look at scores, so a good suggestion is to track the why if it is or not working. Lisa will look into adding that data into our systems.*

- *Question: parent member asked why are we still declining in the iReady score? Is there a way to tell if it is internal or external, it seems that Covid was so long ago to still impact scores? Do we have a new system now that is able to track if it is our students that stay in our school or is it new students to the school?*
- *Response: staff member replied that we have to remember that even though Covid was back a few years, there are still many students behind because there were many kids that were in the lower grades that didn't receive the proper pivotal and foundational learning. Now, these are the students testing that are in the upper grades, but they are still behind and still trying to catch up to what they missed. This is a statewide trend and we will be able to show you how our school compares the state when we can compile that data.*

- *Question: parent member asked if iReady is the state or national requirement or are there other tests that can be used as well?*
- *Response: A member replied that the state of CA has a verified list that we need to use and there are degrees of authenticity, but the other tests don't give very accurate answers, and especially in comparison to CAASPP. We realize it is long, but it gives us the most accurate way to determine where a student actually is and we need a lot of questions to evaluate accurate levels. A shorter 20 minute test cannot give as much detailed information to help the teacher know specifically what the student needs.*

- *Question: parent member asked if it's a possibility that the lower scores can be attributed to the fact that accommodations were previously allowed for students but they were taken away. Can that have accounted for the drop off in results because they were taken away?*



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- *Response: staff member stated she does not believe that this is the reason. IReady is diagnostic and that is why there should not be accommodations. We can follow up with SPED.*

5.4. Intervention Presentation

A presentation on how iReady data drives our intervention program will be led by Assistant Director of Student Services/MTSS, Theresa Tedesco.

- *Question: parent member asked if a student has to have an IEP to be in the tier 3 support*
- *Response: staff member replied yes, because of the intensity of the intervention in that tier, but most students can access tier 2.*
