
REPEATED COURSES POLICY

Sage Oak Charter Schools (“SOCS” or the “Charter School”) adopt this Repeated Courses Policy to apply to all students at SOCS.

Sage Oak Charter Schools is committed to supporting academic and student success. Recognizing that there are times when students do not earn the grade they need to meet graduation requirements, college eligibility, or post secondary goals, the Charter School permits students to repeat courses with certain provisions.

Students may retake any course in which they earned an **F**, with no limit to the number of attempts. This allows students to demonstrate mastery and meet graduation requirements.

Students who earned a **D** may retake the course one time to improve their GPA, particularly in cases where college eligibility, a-g graduation requirements, or academic progress is impacted. Additional retakes of a D-grade course may be permitted only when the course includes new or expanded instruction, meaningfully differentiated assignments or instructional methods, and supports continued academic growth. Such cases require administrative approval and alignment with the student’s academic plan.

Courses that have earned a grade of **C** or better cannot be repeated for higher GPA

When a course is repeated the higher of the two grades will be counted toward the cumulative GPA. However, all attempts and grades will remain visible on the transcript, and repeated courses will be noted with an “/r”.
